Take Route 118 south and follow signs for Study Butte and Big Bend National Park. Big Bend Resort is located at the junction of Routes 118 and FM 170.

From Marathon, TX:

Take Route 385 south, through Big Bend National Park to Panther Junction. Turn right and follow the route out of the Park onto Route 118. Big Bend Resort is at the junction of Route 118 and FM 170.


