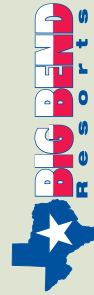
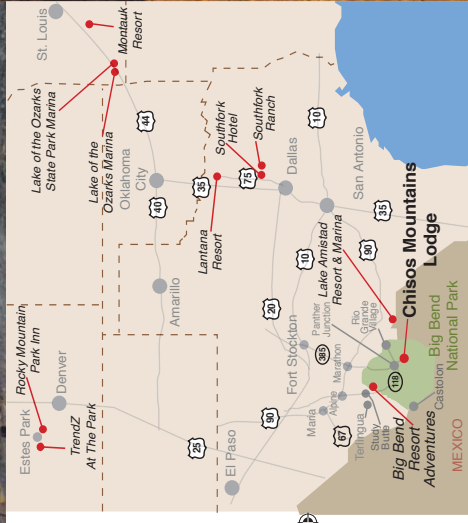




Chisos Mountains Lodge

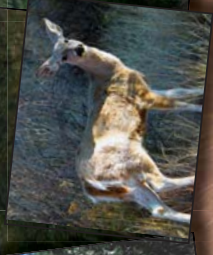
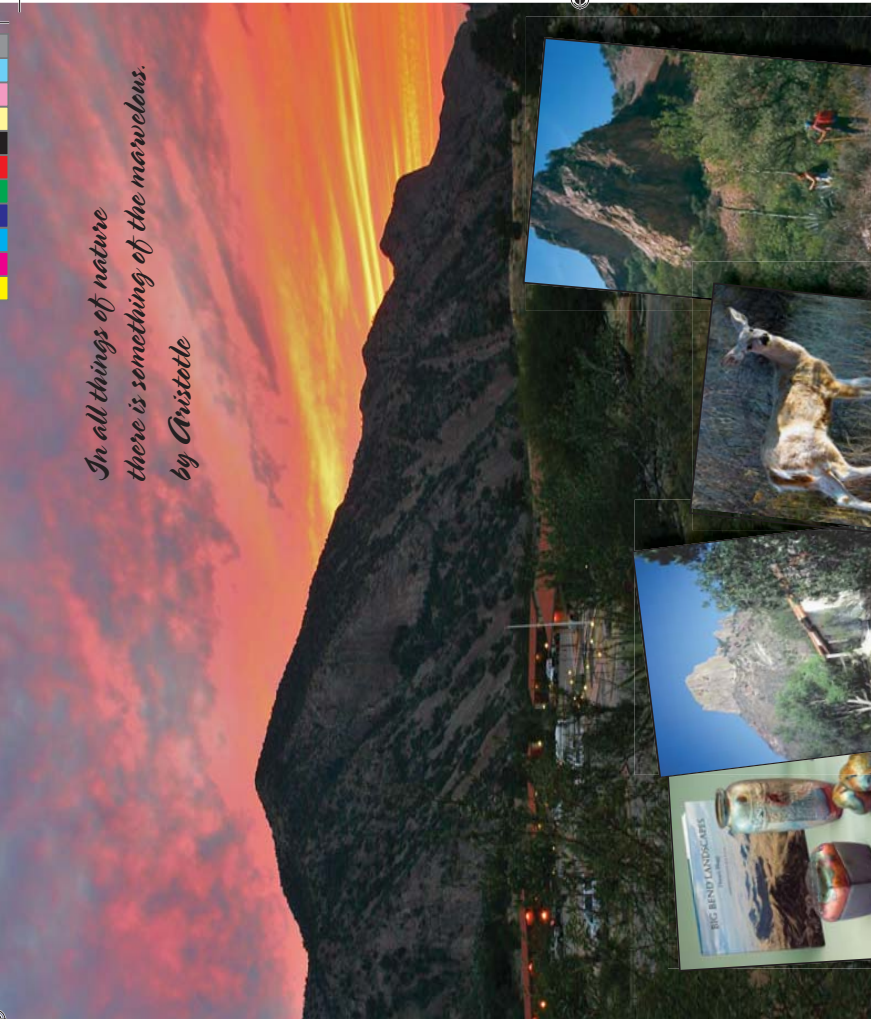
Big Bend National Park TEXAS
